Please write a personal essay (500 words or fewer) in response to the following prompt:

As we reflect on the year 2020--a year that included a global pandemic, numerous natural disasters, racial inequity and civil unrest--what do you see or what can you do that might lead to hope and healing in your community, our state, our nation or the world?

The additional questions below may be helpful in preparing your essay:

- What examples of hope and healing have you seen during the last few months?
- What is the relationship between hope and healing?
- How does humanization impact hope and healing impact?
- How can you influence hope and healing in your community?
- What barriers stand in the way of humanizing, hope and healing? What can you do to remove those barriers?

Essays Guidelines:

- Essays must be <u>no more than 500 words</u> in length
- Essays should be double spaced
- Times New Roman or Arial fonts are preferred.
- Essays may be written in the language of your choice
- Essays must be submitted by filling out this form by Thursday February 18, 2021.

Essay Scoring

Personal Essays will be scored on a point scale of 1 (lowest) to 5 (highest) on how well the essay addresses the following criteria:

- Theme/Essay prompt
- Clarity
- Voice/authenticity

- Is the personal essay double-spaced and no longer than 500 words?
- Are all the questions on the form filled out?
