ONNSFA's 2022-2023 ACADEMIC YEAR ONLINE APPLICATION OPENS

The Office of Navajo Nation Scholarship & Financial Assistance's online application for the 2022-2023 academic term is now open at www.onnsfa.org. The deadline to apply and submit the required documents is 5 pm on June 25, 2022. Online applications submitted before the June 25 deadline cover the upcoming Fall and Spring semesters or Fall, Winter, and Spring quarters. The online application will close at 5 pm on June 25.

Application: Applicants must complete and apply for the 2022-2023 Academic Year. The application may be found at www.onnsfa.org.

Certificate of Indian Blood: New applicants must submit an official Certificate of Indian Blood verifying Navajo enrollment to an agency office. Continuing applicants are not required to submit another official CIB if there is already one on file unless there is a legal name change. A form requesting the Office of Navajo Nation Vital Records to submit a certified CIB on your behalf may be accessed here: https://bit.ly/CIB_request

Official Transcripts: Sealed and unopened official high school transcripts, GED scores, and official transcripts of all colleges attended must be submitted to an agency office via USPS mail or digitally certified and delivered by a school's authorized delivery agent, such as Parchment or the National Student Clearinghouse.

Financial Need Analysis: All students must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). **Full-time applicants:** Submit the ONNSFA's Financial Need Analysis form to your school's financial aid office. A Financial Aid Officer at your school

will complete the document based on the FAFSA's information and return it directly to the ONNSFA. The FNA may be accessed here: http://bit.ly/FNAForm_ONNSFA

Letter of Admission: A Letter of Admission or Re-Admission from the institution the applicant will attend is required.

Graduate applicants must submit two letters of admission indicating full admission status, including one from the graduate college and another from the graduate degree program.

Graduation Degree Checklist: All college juniors, seniors, graduate, and part-time applicants must submit a list of all courses required to complete their degree program. The checklist must include the "expected" graduation date and have an advisor's signature.

Class Schedule: Applicants may upload the following documents in .pdf format to their student account: Letter of admission, graduation degree checklist, and class schedule. All other documents may be mailed to an agency office.

1 PREPARE

Before you apply, gather your paperwork for cross-referencing.

2 APPLY ONLINE

Go to www.onnsfa.org to fill out and submit your application.

3 CREATE AN ACCOUNT

After submitting your application, wait 4-5 business days to “**create an account,**” and gain access to your ONNSFA Student Account.



Create your own username and password to log in.

4 CHECK YOUR DOCUMENTS

Log in to your ONNSFA Student Account to view your missing documents page.

5 REVIEW

Log in regularly to check your document status.

Submit corrections to documents marked with problems.



Once an award/denial decision is made, a letter will generate online.
